- Employees and volunteers of any of the organisations that make up the Staffordshire Safer Roads Partnership are excluded from entering the prize draw.
- By entering the prize draw, you agree to allow SSRP to use your first name in publicity, unless otherwise opting out in writing. We will ask if we can use your full name in publicity if you are a winner.
- By entering the prize draw each contestant agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions.
- Should the promoter believe that an entry contravenes these terms and conditions it reserves the right to delete the entry at its absolute and sole discretion.
- No later than 10 working days following the publicised closure date for submitting a survey and we will draw the winner at random from the eligible entries.
